

New recycling service for businesses launched with City of York Council

City of York Council is encouraging local businesses to recycle more waste with the launch of a new recycling collection service, provided in partnership with Yorwaste, the North Yorkshire recycling and waste management company.



The new recycling service collects paper, cardboard, cans and plastic bottles, providing a simple and cost effective solution for businesses wanting to recycle more of their waste. An information leaflet providing more details about the new service will be distributed to businesses over the next few weeks.

Shaun Donnelly, waste management officer, at City of York Council, explained: "More and more businesses are recognising the importance of effective waste management. There is increasing pressure to reduce the amount of waste being sent to landfill for disposal and costs are increasing significantly each year. It makes good business sense to anticipate the effect that new legislation and increasing costs will have and to look at opportunities for recycling. We believe that the new service offers a practical solution to these issues."

Ken Davidson, head of Strategic Marketing at Yorwaste, added: "Recycling at work is the sensible, sustainable thing to do. It means sending less rubbish to landfill and with Landfill Tax rising by 33 per cent in 2008, and further significant increases due in the next few years, our service can save firms money."
