WHEREAS on the 31st January 1993 the North Yorkshire County Council issued a waste disposal licence (now to be treated as a waste management licence) in pursuance of its powers under the Control of Pollution Act for the above named facility to you.

AND WHEREAS on the 28th of April 1994 the conditions set out therein were modified in accordance with Section 37(1)(a) of the Environment Protection Act 1990.

AND WHEREAS on the 31st of March 1997 conditions 3, 4, 7 and Appendices A and B were modified in accordance with Section 37(1)(b) of the Environment Protection Act 1990.

AND WHEREAS on the 2nd of February 1999 condition 3 was deleted and replaced with condition 3(4) and conditions 7(4) and 10(V) were added and Appendices A and B were deleted and replaced by Appendix A(1) and B(1) in accordance with Section 37 (1)(b) of the Environment Protection Act 1990.

AND WHEREAS on the 22nd of October 2003 the schedule of the licence conditions were deleted and replaced in accordance with Section 37 (1)(a) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Agency modifies the conditions of the said licence in accordance with Section 37 (1)(b) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 and as set out in the Schedule attached to this notice.

SCHEDULE – CONDITIONS RELATING TO THIS MODIFICATION**

Modification of conditions as follows:

- i. Add the attached Appendix A.
- ii. Delete and replace condition 1.2.1 with the follow new condition:

1.2.1 No wastes other than those which are both categorised below in Table 1.2A and specified in detail in section 1.2 of the working plan shall be accepted at the landfill, and no other wastes than those which are categorised below in Table 1.2b and specified in Appendix A shall be accepted at the household waste site.

EXPLANATORY NOTES - including rights of appeal.

RIGHTS OF APPEAL

Section 43(1) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 provides that:

Where, except in pursuance of a direction given by the Secretary of State, the conditions of a licence are modified, the licence holder may appeal from the decision to the Secretary of State.

Therefore, if you feel aggrieved by the decision detailed on the attached notice, you may obtain the appropriate form on which to give written notice of an appeal from :-

This notice of appeal should be accompanied by the following information:

A statement of the grounds of appeal;

A copy of any application to modify the licence

A copy of the licence;

A copy of any correspondence relevant to the appeal;

A copy of any other document relevant to the appeal including, in particular, any relevant consent, determination, notice, planning permission, established use certificate or certificate of lawful use or development and

A statement indicating whether you wish the appeal to be in the form of a hearing or on the basis of written representations.

You are also required to serve a copy of your notice of appeal, together with copies of any the above documents that have accompanied your notice of appeal, on the Environment Agency (at the address overleaf). You should appeal within 6 months of the date that this notice takes effect but the Secretary of State may allow notice of appeal to be given after the expiry of this time period.
