The below specification details the wastes that are acceptable, and those not acceptable in the News & Pams specification:

YES

- ✓ Newspapers
- ✓ Brochures
- ✓ Moisture (less than 10%)



Both examples of News & Pams.

NO

- ✗ Scan board
- ✗ Heavy printed scan
- ✗ Kraft bags with stitching or plastic liners
- ✗ Brown card
- ✗ Wax cartons
- ✗ Waxed board (wet strength or coated)
- ✗ Cores
- ✗ Gift cards
- ✗ Moisture (more than 10%)



This is not News & Pams as it is contaminated with cardboard and other papers.



This is not news and pams. It is hard mix with cardboard and paper.

News & Pams

STRICTLY FORBIDDEN (PROHIBITIVES)

Should **NOT** contain wastes listed in the National Catalogue of Hazardous Wastes, as there is a **0% tolerance**. This includes the following (although this list is not exhaustive):

- ✗ Food waste
- ✗ Garden waste
- ✗ Medical, hygiene and pharmaceutical waste
- ✗ Hazardous waste (paint, chemicals, oil, asbestos)
- ✗ Nappies
- ✗ Concrete, soil, stone and brick
- ✗ Bitumen
- ✗ Electrical equipment, wire or batteries
- ✗ Burnt or partially burnt paper
- ✗ Corrosive, toxic or flammable material
- ✗ Wood
- ✗ Wallpaper
- ✗ Magnetic tape or photosensitive material (e.g. x-ray film, video tape)

NO RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL, EXPLOSIVE WEAPONS OR AMMUNITION IS ALLOWED

Yorwaste guarantee to recycle 100% of acceptable material received. The only exception to this will be any material that does not meet our specification. This may be sent to energy from waste and will be charged if it cannot be placed into another more suitable grade.

Downgrade from News and Pams to Soft or Hard Mixed Paper, general waste or to co-mingled if not meeting correct specification. If contamination is more than 5% details to be noted on weighbridge transaction.
