Collection:

- Liquid waste can contain both water and solids and is either classified as Non-Hazardous or Hazardous.
- A modern purpose-built vehicle will collect the **liquid waste**.

Transfer to Liquid Waste Treatment Plant (LWTP):

- The liquid waste is then taken to a LWTP near you.

Processing:

- Here it undergoes various stages of treatment and settlement where any solids are removed for further treatment or recovery. The aqueous waste is then processed for additional treatment and disposal.

Hazardous liquid waste:

- An example of this type of waste would be an Interceptor on a petrol forecourt where any spillages or run off go into a sealed drainage system.
